Fish sticks approved by board

At the May CLAA board meeting the fisheries committee, chaired by Pat Canney, was authorized to proceed with the proposed fish sticks program. This special project involves using freshly felled trees placed along the shore in order to increase both fish and other wildlife habitat. While the actual placement of the trees will take place later in the winter, the committee will be busy getting DNR permits, applying for a grant, and gathering work materials, machinery and volunteers. We will need trees that are harvested within 90 days of planned placement in February so if you are planning to thin your woods perhaps you could coordinate the cutting time with us.
