## *Curb Pollutants at their source*

**Safely store household toxins, avoid fertilizers, correct eroding soils and maintain your septic system.**

## *Cut Runoff*

**Reduce runoff that picks up pollutants and carries them to the water by minimizing hard surfaces.**

## *Capture & Cleanse*

**Capture and cleanse pollutant-carrying runoff before it reaches the water-with shoreland buffers, rain barrels or rain gardens.**

## Give Natives a Chance everywhere on your property

Minimize suburban turf grass.

**Nurture a mixture of native trees, shrubs, grasses and flowers that can both absorb pollutant run off and provide habitat.**
